The tournament is included in the Computer Ranking Scheme. Players will be ranked based on current computer rating points and ranking list when the draw takes place, based on a **2* Tournament.** No restriction on gender.

Players may enter more than 1 event, 1 in the morning and 1 in the afternoon (total fee of £35 for entering 2 events).

Groups of 7 players in each age category with a round robin per group.

The 1st players will receive a trophy, 2nd and 3rd will receive medals on the day.

Registration and practice from 8:45am, with play to commence at 9:30am.

The organising committee reserves the right to modify the group sizes in light of entries received; any amendments to times will be communicated via email.

General

- 1. The tournament is included in the Computer Ranking Scheme.
- 2. Closing date for entry is **Sunday 30th July 2023 at 5:00pm**.
- 3. Draw will take place on Sunday 6th August 2023 using the latest ranking list when the draw takes place.
- 4. Draw will be sent by Wednesday 9th August 2023.
- 5. Notification of entry will be done via email.
- 6. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 7. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/
- 8. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. Entry Provisions

- 1. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
- 2. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made.

Regulations

- Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to TTE. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete Member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate Single Competition Licence fee with their entry form.
- 2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 4. All competitors will be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
- 5. Players in the various events must have been born as follows:- Under 19 (2005 or later), Under 15 (2009 or later), Under 13 (2011 or later), and Under 11 (2013 or later).
- 6. All matches shall be the best of five games. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions. All players will be required to umpire as scheduled during their group matches, and losers during the KO stages.
- 7. Players' Clothing: As specified in TTE Regulations Part A.
- 8. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 9. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt of the form and payment.
- Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations, and must be sent to <u>amelia.stretton@outlook.com</u>. Full payment at point of entry will be required to secure your entry. Entries received with no payment will not be entered.

Playing conditions

- 1. Court sizes minimum 9x4.5m, with barriers surrounding each court.
- Playing conditions Waldner Classic 25 (ITTF approved) tables, DHS D40+, white balls, general LED lighting minimum 300 lux, height from floor of lighting over table 6 metres, wooden gym floor. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.

Information

- 1. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
- 2. Practice will only be permitted prior to the event starting.



- Photo/livestreaming Birmingham TTA may be taking photos and livestreaming matches during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications. - 4. In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection Policy, persons wishing to take photographs or video images must register with the event organiser, producing their professional identification, TTE authorisation or a completed TTE authorisation form.
- 5. All competitors will be required to book in upon their arrival and should not leave the centre without first obtaining permission from the referee. Players absent when due to play are liable to be scratched from their next match.
- 6. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
- 7. There will be no charge for admission. Entry forms can be downloaded from the TTE website or requested from the organiser or accessed from https://edlynntt.co.uk/birmingham-table-tennis-academy/
- 8. Changing facilities will be available, car parking is available free of charge.
- 9. Trophies/medals will be awarded at the end of the event.
- 10. Players to bring adequate water and refreshments as the venue provides no catering. It is a vegan venue, so no meat or egg products on site.
- 11. Fees will not be refunded 1 week prior to the closing date.
