4 groups of 4 players playing for position, with 2<sup>nd</sup> round of Groups with all winners, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 3<sup>rd</sup> place and 4<sup>th</sup> place playing each other - guaranteed 6 matches

Trophies for Winner and Runner-up of Group1

Open (max 32 entries)

8 groups of 4 players playing for positions, top 2 into Main Draw, and bottom 2 into consolation. Knockout stages through to final of both events - guaranteed 4 match, possible 7 matches Trophies for Winner and Runner-up of Main Draw and Consolation

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### TABLE TENNIS FOR ALL

#### TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

- 1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF
- 2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 4. The "Open" competition is open to all ages. Under 21 must be born in 2002 or later. Over 21 in 2001 or earlier.
- 5. All matches shall be the best of five games. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions. All players will be required to umpire as scheduled during their group matches, and losers during the KO stages.
- 6. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
- 7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 8. Doping shall not take place either before or during play; and doping control tests may take place.
- 9. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations, and must be sent to <a href="mailto:jwramage1@gmail.com">jwramage1@gmail.com</a>. Full payment at point of entry will be required to secure your entry. Entries received with no payment will not be entered.
- 10. Court sizes will be 9m x 4.5m, with barriers surrounding each court.
- 11. Playing conditions Sanwei 3\* white balls, 8/9 Donic Waldner 30mm tables, Donic nets and post, LED lighting is general and 750 lux. Floor to ceiling and floor to lighting height is approximately 6 metres. Flooring in one hall is Gerflor; in the second hall there is a wooden floor. Scoring machines will be used for all matches,
- 12. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made, subject to the discretion of the Referee.
- 13. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 14. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to TTE Codes of Conduct. - 15. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. - 17. Closing date for entry is Friday 19th May 2023 5pm. Draw will take place on Monday 22nd May 2023
- 18. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
- 19. Draw will be sent by Thursday 25th May 2023. Notification of entry will be done via email.
- 20. In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection Policy, persons wishing to take photographs or video images must register with the event organiser, producing their professional identification, TTE authorisation or a completed TTE authorisation form.
- 21. There will be a trophy for Sportwomanship of the tournament, to be presented at the end of the day with the presentation.
- 22. All competitors will be required to book in upon their arrival and should not leave the centre without first obtaining permission from the referee. Players absent when due to play are liable to be scratched from their next match.
- 23. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
- 24. There will be no charge for admission. Entry forms can be downloaded from the TTE website or requested from the organiser.
- 25. Practice will only be permitted prior to the event starting. Changing facilities will be available, including showers.
- 26. Car Parking is available free of charge. Trophies will be awarded at the end of the morning session and afternoon session.
- 27. Refreshments (tea/coffee/water and various drinks) and light snacks will be on sale (chocolate/crisps etc)
- 28. Fees will not be refunded 1 week prior to the closing date.
