TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to TTE. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete Member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate Single Competition Licence fee with their entry form.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
5. Competitors may be expected to umpire group matches at the discretion of the Referee.
6. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis with the exception of preliminary rounds which may, at the discretion of the Referee, be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions.
7. **Competitors in under 21s must be born in 2004 or later.**
8. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
11. All competitors must report to the Control Desk on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
12. Competitors in Banded Singles events must not appear in the Table Tennis England Ltd Rating list current at the closing date of this tournament in the following positions (a) **Men's Band 1 Singles – top 50, Men's Band 2 Singles - top 200, (b) Woman's Banded Singles – top 100. Dummy rankings will be used for foreign entrants.**
13. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
14. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final
15. Racket testing may take place.
16. **No refunds will be given after the Closing Date**
17. **All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.**
18. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see <https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/>
19. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Entry Form - Further entry forms are available from, and should be returned to Welchm48@gmail.com no later than **Saturday 3rd August 2024**
2. Draw - The draw will take place on **15th August 2024** at **5 Alisan Road, Carleton, Poulton-le-Fylde, LANCS. FY6 7QF**. Once completed, and before the date of the tournament, the draw will be sent out and put on the social media.
3. Admission - There will be no charge for admission.
4. Playing Conditions - Play throughout will be on **18 Butterfly Europa 25 tables, nets & posts**, **Butterfly R40 White plastic Seamless balls**, wooden sprung floor and general LED 700 lux lighting 18m above the floor. Court size will be 12m x 6m and 20m from the floor to the ceiling enclosed by surrounds. **Butterfly Scoring machines** will be used for all matches.
5. Doping - Doping control tests may take place.
6. Practice - There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
7. Car Parking - Car parking (at owner's risk) is available at the venue in Car Park 8
8. Refreshments will be on sale throughout serving breakfast, lunch and tea.
9. **Medals and Tees sport Vouchers will be presented to winners and runners up in every event. For 1st place £50 Voucher 2nd place £25 Voucher**
10. Changing rooms are available on site with men's, women's and disabled.

Senior 4* Tournaments – Entry Qualifications

If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt, except that all valid entries for protected places for top30 ranked Seniors, and also top10 ranked Juniors until the 20 July 2024
