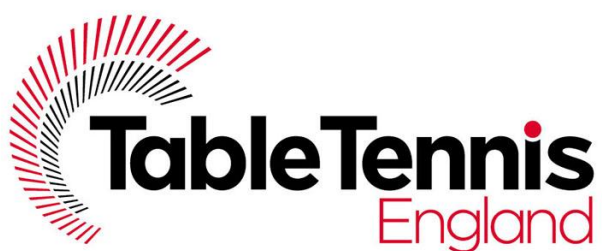

Itinerary

Friday 9th June - Set up

There will be NO ACCESS to the venue on Friday for any players or coaches, without exception.

Saturday – U11's & U13's Competition

All U11 & U13's competitions (Singles and Doubles) will take place in their entirety with games scheduled to start at 09:00 and with the finals scheduled at 18:00.

Sunday – U10's & U12's Competition

The U11's competitions will take place in their entirety, with games scheduled to start at 09:00 and with the finals scheduled at 17:30.

All players must be aware of their game schedule highlighted in the competition programme and must wear their name on the back of their shirts that is clearly visible. It is up to the individual players to be at the table on time.

Practice/Warm Up.

On each day players will be able to practice on the tables from 1 hour prior to the start time. No access will be allowed early than this. We ask that only players use these tables, and no coaches, to give priority to all players.

The Competition

Draw & Schedule

The schedule and draw will be listed in the event programme, a copy will be available on the Table Tennis England website to download and will have copies for each player on the day. The draw is subject to change at the discretion of the referee and all players will be notified of any changes.

Format

SINGLES Competition

The singles competition will be played in groups of 5-7 players and will be played in a round robin format, with the top 2 players progressing to the knock-out stages. Each match will be best of 5 games, 11 up, and the top 2 players going through to knockouts. Groups may be played across 2 tables. The knockout matches will also be played to the best of 5 games, 11 up.

DOUBLES Competition

The doubles matches will be played on a knockout basis, played to the best of 5 games, 11 up.

Registration & Court Access

Registration on both days will be from 08:00, and ALL players will be required to register on your arrival at the venue, on each day they are competing. You will be able to collect an event programme and given any additional information required for the day.

Please note that only players are permitted on the match tables, all players should be suitably attired in sportswear and shoes. Players will have priority during practice at all times, coaches will be asked to vacate the court if other players are waiting.

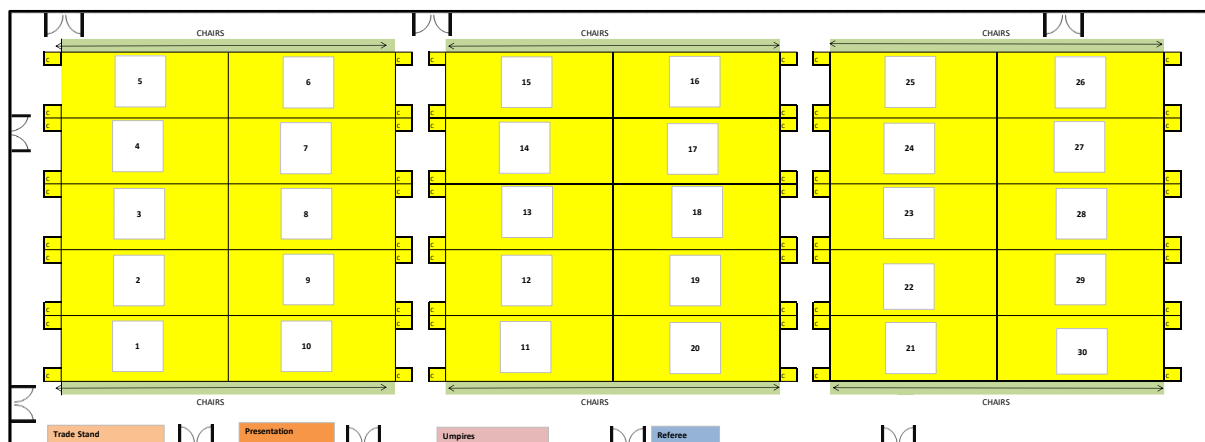
Streaming

The Venue

See below the layout of the Venue, which will be using all 3 halls of the leisure centre. Table numbers are already assigned within the competition draw, issued in the event programme, so please ensure you look for these in advance.



Catering

There is a Café located at the venue which will be open for the duration of the competition on both days. This is run by the venue and will be serving a wide range of both hot and cold meals, drinks and snacks, including Costa Coffee.

Changing Rooms

There will be changing rooms and showers available at the venue, these will not be exclusive to the Table Tennis Competition. We have access to one male and one female changing room. Any valuables left will be at your own risk.

Spectator Area

We encourage spectators to attend this event and the venue has ample viewing space. The venue has a viewing balcony which we would encourage all spectators to watch from, with sight of all match tables. We would like to minimise the number of people in the playing hall as much as possible to just players, coaches, and officials where possible to allow smooth running of the competition.

Parking at the Venue:

There is over 300 free parking spaces at the facility, however this will be shared with other uses of the centre, such as those using the athletics/cycle track and gym which is also located at the venue, so please park respectfully.
