TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- 1. Entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED **by email** to Claire Kelly by no later than Monday 2nd September 2024.
- 2. The Draw will be held on Monday 16th September 2024.
- 3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
- 4. Payment must be made **by bank transfer** by the closing dates (or immediately for late entries).
- 5. Account Name: Waterside Table Tennis Club, Account no: 61194259, Sort Code: 40-25-24, Reference: Player's Full Name followed by SEPT1.
- 6. Hot and cold drinks, snacks are available on site. There is ample free parking and toilets, changing rooms and shower facilities are available at the venue
- 7. White Butterfly R40+ balls will be used.
- 8. Play will take place on up to 8 Donic Delhi 25 tables with Donic Net and post sets and Donic Scoring boards.
- 9. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum Court Size: 9m x 5m.
- 10. Lighting is general & fluorescent lighting. Minimum light intensity is 500 lux. Minimum height of lighting: 7m.
- 11. The venue has gran sprung flooring.
- 12. There will be no admission charge.
- 13. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within 1 days of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out 2 days before the event. If you do not receive this, please get in touch with Claire Kelly.
- 14. No refunds are possible after the closing date under any circumstances.
- 15. The planned format for both the Cadet and Senior competition is groups of 4 and players will be ranked based on the latest computer ranking list. The top 2 players from the group round will go into the main competition knock out rounds and the 3rd & 4th players from the group will go into the consolation knock out rounds.
- 16. The organising committee reserves the right to modify the group sizes in light of entries received; any amendments to times will be communicated via email. Players looking for scratch entries should inform the Organiser in advance to secure their place. Turning up on the day, while allowed, is more risky.
- 17. Definition of each category is: Cadet U15s born in 2010 or later.
- 18. Winners and Runners Up in the U15s Cadet main event and consolation category will receive medals. Winners, Runners Up and Losing Semi Finalists in the Senior main event will receive prize money.
- 19. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
- 20. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 21. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/
- 22. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

- 1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 2. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
- 4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5
- 6. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 7. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low.
- 8. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.
- 9. All competitors may be required to umpire one knockout match in each event entered after being knocked out.
- 10. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Please speak to the referee if you think you need permission for other attire. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
- 11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.
- 12. No gluing up or boosting/tuning will be allowed.
- 13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
- 15. Photo/livestreaming: Waterside Table Tennis Club and Hampshire County Table Tennis may be taking photos and live streaming matches during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications.
