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TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)

Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF. . An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may apply to TTE for a One-Time Tournament Pass (**OTTP**). It is not possible to obtain this at the tournament: **the OTTP can be purchased through your Sport80 account. If you do not already have a Sport 80 account you can register at <https://auth.sport80.com/register> “**

2. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to this tournament. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
3. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
4. Players may be expected to umpire group matches.
5. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
6. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis with the exception of preliminary rounds, which may, at the discretion of the Referee, be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions.
7. Competitors in Junior events must be born in 2006 or later
8. Competitors in Under 17 events must be born in 2008 or later,
9. Competitors in Cadet events must be born in 2010 or later,
10. Competitors in Under 13 events must be born in 2012 or later.
11. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
12. Doping shall not take place either before or during play
13. All competitors must report to the control on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.

2. Draw - The draw will take place at 7:00pm on Tuesday 17th September 2024 at 5 Alisan Road, Carleton, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire. FY6 7QF.
3. Admission - There will be no charge for admission.
4. Playing Conditions - Play throughout will be on, up to 12 Butterfly tables & nets, Stiga 3* white 40+ balls, Gransprung & pvc floor and 750 lux LED lighting at a minimum of 8m. court size will be 9m x 4.5m enclosed by surrounds. Scoring machines will be used for all matches,
5. Practice - There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
6. Car Parking – Free Car parking (at owner's risk) is available at the venue.
7. Changing facilities and showers are available.
8. Refreshments - Light refreshments will be on sale.
9. Prizes – Trophies will be awarded to all Winners & Runners Up.
10. Notification - Competitors will be notified of the time of their first match.
11. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
