#### **TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS** (to be retained)

Margaret Welch (TO3)

- 1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <a href="https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/">https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/</a>. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate One-Time Tournament Top-Up fee via <a href="https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/">https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/</a>. It is not possible to obtain the OTTP or the OTTT at the tournament.
- 2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 5. Competitors may be expected to umpire group matches at the discretion of the Referee.
- 6. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis with the exception of preliminary rounds, which may, at the discretion of the Referee, be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions.
- 7. Competitors in Junior events must have been born in 2006 or later. Competitors in Cadet events must have been born in 2010 or later. Competitors in Under 13 events must have been born in 2012 or later.
- 8. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
- 9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
- 11. All competitors must report to the Booking In/ Control Desk on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 12. Competitors in Banded Singles events must not appear in the Table Tennis England Ltd Rating list current at the closing date of this tournament in the following positions (a) Junior Boys' Band 1 Singles top 50, Junior Boys' Band 2 Singles top 150, (b) Junior Girls' Band 1 Singles top 20, Junior Girls' Band 2 Singles top 60, (c) Cadet Boys' Band 1 Singles top 20, Cadet Boys' Band 2 Singles top 125, (d) Cadet Girls' Band 1 Singles top 10, Cadet Girls' Band 2 Singles top 60. Dummy rankings will be used for foreign entrants.
- 13. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event. There will be no consolation or plate events at this tournament.
- 14. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.
- 15. Racket testing may take place.
- 16. No refunds will be given after the closing date and a fee of £10 per entry may also be charged for any late entries.
- 17. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 18. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. - 19. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. #### **TOURNAMENT INFORMATION**

- 1. Entry Form Further entry forms are available from, and should be returned to Cathy Steeples, 4 Birmingham Close Grantham LINCS NG31 8SD no later than Friday 11<sup>th</sup> October 2024. Cheques should be made payable to Cliffedale Chandlers. Entries without fees will not be accepted. Electronic entries are accepted and can be sent to <a href="mailto:cmm">cmsteeples@hotmail.com</a> with the player's name being used as the reference (BACS details are on the entry form itself).
- 2. Draw The draw will take place on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October 2024 at 5 Alisan Road, Poulton-le-Fylde, LANCS, FY6 7QF.
- 3. Admission There will be no charge for admission.
- 4. Playing Conditions Play throughout will be on 18 Joola tables & nets, **Joola Flash 3\* seamless white plastic balls**, wooden sprung floor and general LED lighting a minimum of 5m above the table. Court size will be 10m x 5m enclosed by surrounds. Joola scoring machines will be used for all matches.
- 5. Doping Doping control tests may take place.
- 6. Practice There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
- 7. Car Parking Free car parking (at owner's risk) is available at the venue.
- 8. Changing facilities (men's, women's and disabled) and showers are available.
- 9. Refreshments Light refreshments will be on sale.
- 10. Prizes Trophies will be awarded to all Winners & Runners Up.
- 11. Notification Once completed, and before the date of the tournament, the draw will be emailed out to players, to include the timings for group matches.

#### Junior 4\* Tournaments - Entry Qualifications

If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt except that all valid entries for Junior Boys rated 1-50 in the rating list current at the closing date and for Junior Girls, Cadet Boys and Cadet Girls rated 1-32 will be accepted, with priority thereafter being given to Junior Boys rated 51-500 and Junior Girls rated 33-250.
