This is a rating style competition with a maximum entry of 16 players in each age group. Providing that we reach maximum capacity, players will be split into two group of 8. The top 8 highest TTE rated players will play in Band A, with the remainder playing in Band B. With a maximum number of entries, each entrant will play seven matches. Each group will play across two tables. A cadet age player can enter both events should they wish. Please be aware that this could mean up to 14 matches over the course of the day.

The tournament is included in the Computer Ranking Scheme.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- 1. Entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED by email to Henry Arthur by no later than Monday 9 September 2024. Entry fee per event is £20.
- 2. The Draw will be held on Wednesday 11 September 2024.
- 3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
- 4. Payment must be made by bank transfer by the closing dates (or immediately for late entries).

- 6. Hot/cold drinks will be available to purchase. There is free parking and toilets.
- 7. Double Fish V40+ 3*balls will be used.
- **8.** Play will take place on 4 Butterfly National League 22 tables with Butterfly Net and post sets and Butterfly Scoring boards.
- 9. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum Court Size: 9m x 4.5m
- **10.** Minimum light intensity is 500 lux LED general lighting. Minimum height of lighting: 7m.
- **11.** The venue has wood sprung flooring.
- **12.** There will be no admission charge.
- **13.** Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within 3 days of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out 2 days before the event. If you do not receive this, please get in touch with Henry Arthur.
- **14.** No refunds are possible after the closing date under any circumstances.
- **15.** This is a rating tournament. Groups of 8 (round robin per group). Players will be ranked based on their TTE rating points from the 24/1 publication due out on 11 September. Players without a TTE ranking/rating will be placed in the lowest group unless evidence can be provided that suggests the player should be given a higher dummy rating.
- **16.** The organising committee reserves the right to modify the group sizes in light of entries received; any amendments will be communicated via email. Players looking for scratch entries should inform the Organiser in advance to secure their place. Turning up on the day, while allowed, is more risky.
- 17. Definition of each category is: Cadet U15s born in 2010 or later. Junior U19s-born in 2006 or later.
- 18. Band winners and runner-up will receive medals.
- **19.** The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
- **20.** All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 21. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see <u>Safeguarding Codes of Conduct & Terms of Reference - Table Tennis</u> <u>England</u>
- 22. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.

2. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.

3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/ It is not possible to obtain the OTTP at the tournament.

4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.

5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5

6. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.

7. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low.

8. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.

9. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered

10. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Please speak to the referee if you think you need permission for other attire. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.

11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.

12. No gluing up or boosting/tuning will be allowed.

13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.

14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.

15. Photo/livestreaming: Corby Table Tennis Club and Northants County Table Tennis may be taking photos and live streaming matches during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications.
