The tournament is included in the TTE Computer Ranking Scheme. Players will be ranked based on the current computer rating points and ranking / rating points, no restriction on gender (separate gender groups will run if enough entries) based on a **1* Tournament**.

Players will be ranked based on the latest computer ranking list. Groups of 6 with a round robin per group, groups will be mixed if there are not enough male/female players in each category. The organising committee reserves the right to modify the group sizes in light of entries received; any amendments to times will be communicated via email.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> It is not possible to obtain the OTTP at the tournament.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. The competition is open to a maximum of 30/32 players, and group sizes based on entrants, groups may be mixed between male/female if there are insufficient entrants.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.

6. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended. Balls being used will be white.
7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
8. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations, and must be sent to pawelmeryn@yahoo.com. Full payment at point of entry will be required to secure your entry. Entries received with no payment will not be entered.
9. Playing conditions – Tibhar SL 3* white balls, five Cornilleau 840 wood tables and nets, LED lighting is general and 500 lux. Floor to ceiling and floor to lighting height is approximately 4 metres. Flooring in hall is Vinyl. Scoring machines and TIBHAR umpire tables will be used for all matches. Court sizes will be 10m x 4m, with barriers surrounding each court.
10. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made, subject to the discretion of the Referee.
11. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to TTE Codes of Conduct. Please see <https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/>
12. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. 14. Entry closing date Friday 6th September 2024 5pm. Draw will be posted on the day
15. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt. You are encouraged to enter early to avoid disappointment.
16. In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection Policy, persons wishing to take photographs or video images must register with the event organiser, producing their professional identification, TTE authorisation or a completed TTE authorisation form which can be obtain from the organiser.
17. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
18. All competitors will be required to book in upon their arrival, should not leave the centre hall without notifying the referee. Players absent when due to play are liable to be scratched from their next match. Practice will only be permitted prior to event starting.
19. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
20. There will be no charge for admission. Entry forms can be downloaded from the TTE website or requested from the organiser.
21. Changing facilities will be available, including showers. Practice will only be permitted prior to the event starting.
22. Light refreshments will be on sale
23. All group winners will receive a £30 BRIBAR voucher, Runners Up will receive a £20 BRIBAR voucher and players finishing in 3rd place will receive a table tennis gift to the value of £10.

25. Doping shall not take place either before or during play and doping control tests may take place.
