## TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

- Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <u>https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/</u> It is not possible to obtain the OTTP at the tournament
- 2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form
- 4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations. There is a limit of two events any one player can enter, their own age group and the one above
- 5. Players will be expected to umpire group matches and next match after a loss.
- 6. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended
- All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a group basis followed by a knockout depending on entries. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions
- 8. Competitors in Junior events must be born in 2006 or later; Competitors in Cadet events must be born in 2010 or later;

Competitors in Under 13 events must be born in 2012 or later; Competitors in Under 11 events must be born in 2014 or later

- 9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play and doping control tests may take place.
- 11. All competitors must report to the control on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched

- 4. Playing Conditions Play throughout will be on, up to 10 Butterfly tables & nets, Butterfly R40 3\* white balls, i gransprung floor and 1000 lux LED lighting at a minimum of 4m, court size will be 9m x 4.5m enclosed by surrounds. Scoring machines will be used for all matches,
- 5. Practice There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee
- 6. Car parking at centre (at owner's own risk).
- 7. Changing facilities and showers are available.
- 8. Refreshments Light refreshments should be on sale.
- 9. Prizes Trophies or medals will be awarded to all Winners & Runners Up.

- 10. Notification Competitors will be notified of the time of their first match.
- 11. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
