TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED by email to Brett Holt by no later than Friday 29th November 2024.
- 2. The Draw will be held on Tuesday 3rd December 2024.
- 3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt. Late entries will only be accepted if there is still space in the appropriate event after the closing date.
- 4. Payment must be made by bank transfer by the closing date (or immediately for late entries).

- 5. There is ample free parking. There are changing rooms & shower facilities too. Food & Drink stands will be available at the venue.
- 6. DHS DJ40+ 3-star white balls will be used.
- 7. Play will take place on up to **9x Donic/Butterfly** tables with **Butterfly Europa** nets and posts and with **Butterfly** scoring machines.
- 8. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height: 10m; Minimum Court Size: 10m X 5m.
- 9. Lighting is general and fluorescent lighting. The minimum Light intensity is 500 lux. Minimum height of lighting: 10m.
- 10. The venue has wooden sprung flooring.
- 11. There will be no admission charge.
- 12. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within 1 day of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out 2 days before the event. If you do not receive this, please get in touch with the referee.
- 13. No refunds are possible after the closing date under any circumstances.
- 14. The planned format is a double-group system followed by a knockout! The groups will be organised based on the current ranking. Unranked players may be placed in a higher group if deemed appropriate by the Organising Committee. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Referee in light of entries received. Players looking for scratch entries should inform the Organiser in advance to secure their place. Turning up on the day, while allowed, is riskier.
- 15. There will be prize money and trophies for the winners & runners-up in the main draw & consolation. Prize Money. £1000 Open Winner, £500 for the Runner- up, £250 for each losing semi-finalist & £150 each losing quarter-finalist. £250 Open Consolation Winner, £150 for the Runner- up, £100 for each losing semi-finalist & £50 each losing quarter-finalist. Prize pot total £3400
- 16. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

- 1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 2. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/ An entrant only affiliated as a Compete member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate One-Time Tournament Top-Up fee via https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/ It is not possible to obtain the OTTP or the OTTT at the tournament.
- 4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
- 6. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 7. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low. No refunds or transfers will be offered should merging occur.
- 8. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.
- 9. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
- 10. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings, or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks, and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers, or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended. Markings or trimming on the front or side of a playing
- garment and objects such as jewellery worn by a player shall not be so conspicuous or brightly reflecting as to unsight an opponent. ITTF 3.2.2.5"
- 11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.
- 12. No gluing up or boosting/tuning will be allowed.
- 13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
- 15. Competitors must have been born in any year for the open senior event.
- 16. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 17. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/
- 18. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if
