Pathway Development Team Cup 2025/26 Host Venue Criteria



Theis is an exciting opportunity for a Table Tennis England Affiliated Club to host the inaugural Pathway Development Team Cup on a partnership basis in the 2025/26 season, which will be taking place in May 2026.

General Event information:

The Pathway Development Team Cup comprises boy's and girl's teams in both U11 and U13 age groups. They will be representing their Area/PDC (using counties to determine Area eligibility) and will be an opportunity for priority age-groups at area level, where critical mass does not exist at club or country level, as a springboard to National Leagues.

Schedule/Timings

The event will take place over two days, with one age group playing on each day, so each age group will conclude within a single day.

On both days registration and warm up is expected to start at 08:30, with the first game commencing at 09:30 and presentations approx. 17:50.

All 7 Areas will field a team in both age groups and both genders, that will play a round robin, in a Corbillon Cup format with matches played best-of-3. Therefore, there will be 3 concurrent fixtures involving 6 teams, and each of those fixtures played across 2 tables. 12 tables are required per day.
