TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)

1. Every entrant must be Affiliated to ETTA Ltd as a Player Member.
2. ETTA Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament including Regulation R (Racket Re-Rubbing). ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
3. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signify agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including the variations from the ITTF requirements.
4. All competitors will be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis with the exception of preliminary rounds, which may, at the discretion of the Referee, be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions.
7. Players clothing: Main colour of clothing must be different from the colour of the ball (x).
8. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
9. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
10. All competitors must report to the control on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
11. Foreign players will be given dummy ratings.
12. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
13. Competitors will not be allowed to glue up with in the confines of the Centre under any circumstances.
14. The referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.

2. Entries - If it is necessary to restrict entries this will be done on the bases of the last received, first out.
3. Draw - The draw will take place at 16:00 on 1st July 2011 at William Hunter House, 20 Western Road, Brentwood, Essex, CM14 4SR.
4. Admission - There will be no charge for admission.
5. Playing Conditions - Play throughout will be on 10 Tibhar Smash tables with Tibhar nets. Joola 3* Gold white balls, Hall will have green tarkett multisport 2.0 plastic top on sprung wood base flooring. Court size will be 9m x 4.57m (x) enclosed by surrounds. Scoring machines will be used for all matches. Assistant umpires will not be appointed.
6. Doping - Doping control tests may take place.
7. Practice - There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
8. Car Parking - Car Parking (at owners risk) is available at the venue.
9. Refreshments - Light refreshments will be on sale.
10. Changing facilities with showers are available.
11. Prizes – Trophies will be awarded to all Winners & Runners Up.
12. Notification - Competitors will be notified of the time of their first match together with directions to the Venue.

No entry will be accepted unless the following undertaking is signed:
