RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ALL CATEGORIES

The festival is open to all individuals who register not later than 30 minutes before the start of each category. Any restrictions regarding the start in a particular category are due to the specificity of that category.

Every player must have a valid medical certificate confirming his or her ability to play table tennis, otherwise the Organiser will require from the participant concerned a written declaration of ability to compete in the Festival.

The 1st round matches in all categories will be played in groups of 3 to 6 players, with the first two players qualifying for the next round. The first 2 players qualify for the knockout stage. A player with 1 defeat cannot be ranked higher than at 3rd place, eventually.

In doubles all play all in that category and players can have maximum two defeats. However, a player with 1 defeat cannot be ranked higher than at 3rd place.

Best 4 players in each category will receive material prizes, and, in some categories, additional prizes funded by the Festival sponsors are envisaged.

Plays will be in accordance with the ITTF rules. All matches are played to 3 won sets. All categories are launched and finished on the same day.

Memo:

If less than 9 players register for a particular category, all play all in that category.

Entry fees:

- women 35+ (G), men aged 60-69 (W3) as well as 70+ in Veterans singles (W4) pay no fees;
- junior boys (I) and junior girls (J) in singles OPEN 10 PLN;
- singles OPEN incl. Polish 3. League (C), amateur singles not affiliated to the Polish Table Tennis Federation (H), men in categories Veterans aged 40-49, 50-59 (W1-W2) 15 PLN;
- men's (A) and women's (B) singles Super OPEN, doubles OPEN (D) 20 PLN.
