RULES

1. All players must be in full time education.
2. Eight events – Boys' and Girls' under 19, under 16, under 13, and under 11. **Ages as at 1st September 2020**
3. Players may enter **ONE EVENT** only. They may enter the age group above, but NOT TWO AGE GROUPS ABOVE
4. Entries to the Organiser by 30th January 2020

6. Players, or Persons in Charge, should report to control by **TIME at the latest**. Late arrivals are liable to be scratched.
7. Suitable sportswear **MUST** be worn. **NO WHITE CLOTHING**. Tracksuit trousers not to be worn during play. No narrow heeled shoes to be worn in the playing arena.
8. No drinks allowed in the playing area unless in resealable screw topped containers.
9. All correspondence or requests for information re the competition should be addressed to the Organiser.
10. By entering schools confirm they have ensured players, parents and guardians have given consent to appear in photographs and videos taken during these events to be used in publicity material, press releases on Table Tennis England, ESTTA and JPF websites. Schools also confirm they are happy to be signed up to the Table Tennis England Schools Newsletter.
11. Matches will be played best of 3 or 5 games (depending on the number of entries and time available), 11 up changing service after every 2 points.
12. No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate fees or unless receipt of fees is confirmed by Table Tennis England at least one week before the date of the competition.

It is hoped to play in groups. The number in each group will depend on the size of entry.

**The winner of each age group will represent their county in the Butterfly National Schools' Individual Championship on Saturday 25th April at Aldersley Leisure Village, Wolverhampton, West Midlands, WV6 9NM.
One Runner-Up in each age group may be nominated to be invited if they are considered of sufficient standard and if there are places available.**
