English Schools Table Tennis Championships



How to enter

Team Championships

- Q. Can any school enter a team in this competition?
A. Yes - the Championships are open to all schools - state and independent, primary and secondary.
- Q. How many players are there in a team?
A. A team consists of four players (except Under 19 Girls - two players).
- Q. Are there fixed age groups?
A. Yes - Under-19, Under-16, Under-13 and Under-11 - both Boys and Girls.
- Q. When is the competition played?
A. The first rounds of the competition are played at county level, normally in the September to November period.
- Q. Who does the school contact for an entry form?
A. Contact your Schools' County Secretary.
- Q. What happens if a school wins the Schools' County Championship?
A. They proceed to the Zone Finals and if successful, then to the Regional and National Finals.

Individual Championships

- Q. Who can play in this event?
A. Any player in full-time education at a school in England.
- Q. Are there fixed age groups?
A. Yes - the same as for the Team Championships.
- Q. When is the competition played?
A. The first rounds of the competitions are played at county level, normally in January/February but could be in the Autumn Term.
- Q. Who does the school contact for an entry form?
A. Contact your Schools' County Secretary.
- Q. What happens if a player wins their Schools' County Championship?
A. They proceed directly to the National Finals.
