JOOLA WORLD CUP 22 TABLE

Amazing 22mm table on lightweight but sturdy twin roller undercarriage. Easy set up and telescoping halves permit storage in tight areas. The table offers outstanding value for money, providing easy manoeuvrability, solid 22m top and the requirement of only limited storage space.

How many tables can we order?

The standard schools packages are 2 indoor tables or 1 outdoor table. You are able to add additional tables to your order to suit your requirements, there is no limit to the number of tables you can order. The exclusive prices are only available through the Table Tennis England schools package offer.

Can we order an indoor and an outdoor package?

Both packages are great for schools and there is no problem with ordering any number of each with any order. Please remember, you will receive a separate invoice for your indoor/outdoor packages so include separate PO numbers on your order form.

What is in the resource pack?

The introductory resource pack includes the following -

- Ladder Board
- USB of resources, skills, drills and templates
- 'Join the fun' promotion posters
- Certificates and medals

If you order more than one package type together you will receive more than one resource pack.

Can we add more equipment to our order?

You can add extra bats, balls or sports bags to your order (Not available on IPP packages). Take advantage of the exclusive prices when ordering a schools table package through Table Tennis England. You can find the price list for additional equipment at the end of this document.

Additional items purchased at the same time as the original order will be supplied without additional delivery charge. Delivery charges will be quoted upon request for any subsequent orders.

When will we know when our table delivery will come?

The table supplier will contact your named delivery contact to arrange a day and time. IPP packages will be sent by next day delivery by courier.



Can we apply for additional funding?

A grant scheme in conjunction with the schools packages is available in February and March 2016 for primary schools in England (Ages 5-11). See below for more information.

Primary School Grant Scheme (Open from 1st February to 14th March 2016 only, subject to availability)

What is the primary school grant?

There is a small pot of funding available to subsidise the cost of indoor/outdoor table packages from Table Tennis England. Grants of £300.00 will be awarded to primary schools who meet the criteria laid out in the grant application form. Only one grant will be awarded per school.

How is eligible for the grant?

The Primary School Grant is only available to primary and junior/middle schools in England (catering for at least two year groups within KS2). Fee paying schools and lower/first schools not catering for at least 2 year groups within KS2 are not eligible.

What can we spend the primary schools grant on?

The primary school grant is available on an indoor or outdoor package within the Table Tennis England school offer only. The grant is not available on the IPP package or the cost of any other table purchase. A grant application must be submitted with an order where you can select an outdoor or indoor package.

If successful, how will we receive the grant?

The supplier, Bribar Table Tennis (indoor) or UK Table Tennis (outdoor), will invoice your school for the full amount. Upon receipt of proof of invoice from the supplier Table Tennis England will release the grant of £300 to your school (please note the grant is non-vatable).

Why do recipients have to provide data on usage following the grant scheme?

As part of the funding agreement, schools will be asked to provide Table Tennis England with monitoring data. Data provided will help Table Tennis England assess the success and reach of the Primary School grant scheme including the impact on participation levels. Schools are asked to fill out a monitoring form 3-6 months after delivery of the tables.

How do we apply for a grant?

When is the deadline for applications and when will we hear if we are successful?

The closing dates for applications are:

9AM Monday 22nd February 2016



9AM Monday 14th March 2016 (subject to availability)

Submitted applications will be assessed no more than one week after the closing date. You will be informed of the success of your application no more than 10 days after the closing date.

If my school is not successful can we still buy tables at the exclusive rate?

Yes this opportunity is still available to unsuccessful schools. The school package prices are available to all schools (ages 5-16) in England.

How will our grant application be assessed?

Your application will be evaluated against the following criteria:

- **Current table tennis provisions**
- **Proof of school's desire to deliver table tennis**
- **Planned programme of table tennis opportunities**
- **Sustainability of table tennis at your school**

Our school already has tables (through a Table Donation Scheme or otherwise), can we still apply?

Yes you can still apply. In your application you need to show how your school has made the most of the tables you already have and young people would benefit further by having more tables.
