## TOURNAMENT REGULATION

1. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament). ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
2. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Player Member or Licensed Player to Table Tennis England, or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
3. Completion and submission of the entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including variations from the ITTF requirements, and to the storage of information about the competitor on a computer system.
4. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. Events will be played initially in groups followed by knockout stages dependent on entries. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Organiser in the light of entries received.
5. Competitors may enter any event subject to eligibility.
6. Competitors must report to Control on arrival, at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start times, and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
7. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event.
8. Competitors will be permitted to practise on match tables at the discretion of the Referee.
9. Players will be expected to umpire matches during group play, and in the knock-out stages. No assistant umpires will be appointed at any stage.
10. Clothing: The main colour of a shirt, skirt or shorts, other than the sleeves and collar of a shirt shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use.
11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
12. No gluing up will be allowed in the building.
13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
15. Competitors must be born on or after 1st January 2004 (Under 13), 2002 or later (under 15 cadet) and in 1999 or later (under 18 junior).

## TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Submit entries to Tournament Referee, **TIM HARRIS**, **8 Harford Close, Coombe Dingle, Bristol, BS9 2QD** by no later than **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2017** together with a stamped, self-addressed envelope unless email address given.
3. If it is necessary to restrict entries, restriction will be on the basis of last received, first out.
4. Competitors will be informed of the times of their opening matches at least 5 days in advance.
5. Light refreshments will be available in the hall. Sainsbury's store is within 10 minute walking distant (Fox Den Road, BS34 8SS, Sun open 10am-4pm).
6. Play will take place on up to 14 Butterfly tables with scoring machines.
7. Play will be with Butterfly 3 star white plastic balls.
8. Tables will be courted with minimum court size 10m x 4.57m.
9. Lighting is general and is high frequency fluorescent.
10. Play will be on wooden sports flooring in the sport of sized 36m\*34m with 22m ceiling height.
11. There will be no admission charge. On site free parking is available.
12. Dope and bat testing may take place.
13. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
14. Trophies will be awarded in all events.
15. Draw – The draw will take place at 7p.m. on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> January 2017 at 8 Harford Close, Bristol BS9 2QD.
16. No refunds of entry fees will be made after the draw.
