#### **TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)**

1. Every entrant must be affiliated to Table Tennis England as a Player Member or be a Member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. Every player must hold a valid Table Tennis England Player License or have paid the appropriate single competition license fee with his/her entry form unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another national association affiliated to the ITTF, and is not affiliated to Table Tennis England, or pay the STL fee.
3. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament including Regulation R (Racket Re-Rubbering). ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signify agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including the variations from the ITTF requirements.
5. Competitors maybe required to umpire group matches and knockout matches at the discretion of the Referee.
6. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis, with the exception of preliminary rounds, which may, at the discretion of the Referee, be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions.
7. Competitors must be born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2007 or later (U11), 2005 or later (Under 13), 2003 or later (under 15 cadet) and 2000 or later (under 18 Junior).
8. Players' clothing: main colour of clothing must be different from the colour of balls. White balls will be used in this tournament.
9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
11. All competitors must report to the control on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
12. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event.
13. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
14. The referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final
15. Racket testing may take place.
16. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.

### Tournament Information

1. Submit entries to Tournament Organiser: **Paul Whiting, 34 Lake View Drive, Tamerton, Plymouth, Devon PL5 4JZ** by no later than **20<sup>th</sup> August 2017** together with a stamped, self-addressed envelope unless email address given.
2. The draw will be held on **26<sup>th</sup> August 2017**.
3. If it is necessary to restrict entries, restriction will be on the basis of last received, first out.
4. Competitors will be informed of the times of their opening matches at least 5 days in advance.
5. Refreshments including hot food and changing rooms will be available at the venue, together with ample free parking.
6. Play will take place on up to 12 Joola tables with scoring machines.
7. Play will be with 3 star white Xushaofa plastic balls.
8. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height 3.2m, minimum court size 9m x 5.0m.
9. Lighting is general and is high frequency fluorescent.
10. Play will be on rubberised compound sports flooring. (GERFLOR)
11. There will be no admission charge.
12. Dope and bat testing may take place.
13. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
14. Trophies will be awarded in all events.
15. The Entry Form will incorporate an undertaking as follows:-
