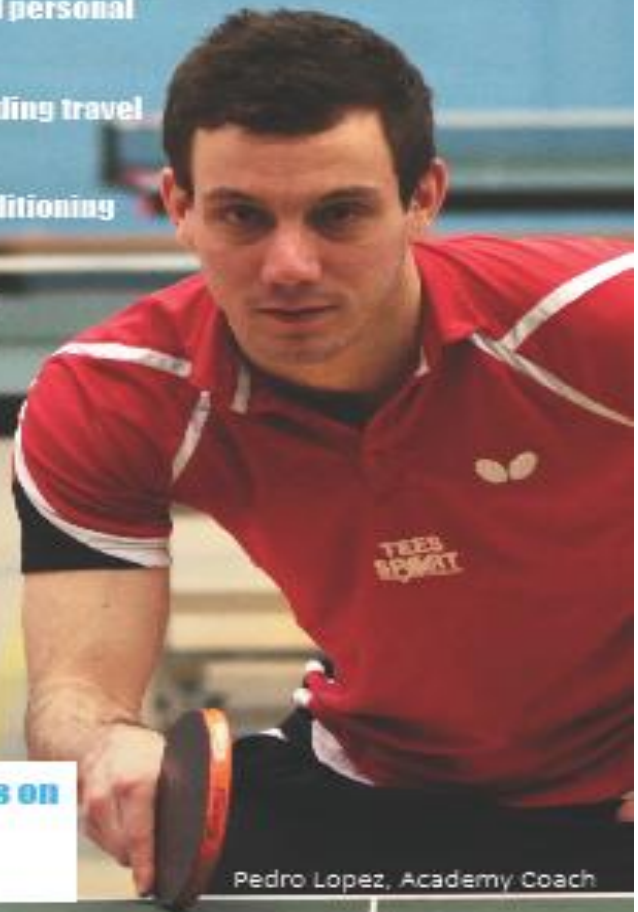

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament. ITTF regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
2. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Player Member or Licensed Player to Table Tennis England, or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
3. Every player must hold a valid Table Tennis England Player Licence or have paid the appropriate Single Competition Licence Fee with their entry form unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another national association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to Table Tennis England.
4. Racket testing may take place at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
5. Completion and submission of the entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including variations from the ITTF requirements, and to the storage of information about the competitor on a computer system.
6. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. Events will be played initially in groups followed by knockout stages dependent on entries. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Organiser in the light of entries received.
7. Rackets must conform to ITTF Regulation 3.2.1.3
8. The Referee's decision on points of fact by an Umpire or Assistant Umpire appointed by the referee shall be final. The Referees decision shall be final on point of law, in any dispute as to the interpretation of these Regulations and in any matter not covered by them.
9. Competitors may enter any event subject to eligibility.
10. Competitors must report to Control on arrival, at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start times, and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
11. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event.
12. At the discretion of the Referee competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables not in use. **No Cross Knocking.** Dedicated practice tables will not be available.
13. Competitors may be asked to umpire group matches. Assistant Umpires will be appointed for all finals (x) only at the Referees discretion.
14. **Clothing:** The main colour of a shirt, skirt or shorts other than the sleeves and collar of a shirt shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. It would be appreciated if competitors in the team events dressed uniformly but this is not mandatory (x). ITTF Regulation 3.2.2.8 regarding clothing will not apply (x).
15. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
16. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
17. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
18. Competitors in Junior events must be born after 31st December 1999
19. Competitors in Cadet events must be born after 31st December 2002
20. Competitors in Under 12 events must be born after 31st December 2005
21. Entry to Graded events is restricted according to the Table Tennis England List current at the closing date for entries. Restrictions are as follows:

1	25 and below	17 and below

Junior 4* Tournaments – Entry Qualifications

If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, this will be done on the following basis of last received first out, with the following exception: For players affiliated to Table Tennis England, valid entries for Junior Boys rated 1–50 in the rating list current at the closing, Junior girls 1-32, cadet Boys rated 1–32 and Cadet Girls rated 1–32 are guaranteed to be accepted. Thereafter, entries will be accepted in order of receipt, with priority given to Junior Boys rated 51-500 and Junior Girls rated 33-250.

No Entry will be accepted unless the following undertaking is signed on the entry form

I undertake

1. To observe the regulations of the tournament
2. To abide by the decisions of the referee and the Organising Committee
3. To fulfil the schedule of play arranged for me unless prevented by circumstances beyond my control, and accepted as such by the referee.

Team Event Regulations

1. The tournament regulations printed above apply to the team events.
2. Under no circumstances will players be paired up for team events. Please ensure that a bona-fide club name is used.
3. Competitors who only enter the team event must enter their Membership/ Player Licence Number and sign the undertaking on the singles entry form. Players without a licence must pay a Single Competition Licence Fee.
4. Cadet players may compete in one team event only, either the Cadet Team events or the Junior Team Events, however, the Cadet Singles may be scheduled for play at the same time as the Junior Team events.
5. The team event will be played under the following regulations
 - 5.1 Teams shall be represented in a match by two singles players and a doubles pair selected from those nominated for the event.
 - 5.2 Up to 4 players may be nominated by their National Association or their affiliated club
 - 5.3 A team match will consist of up to 4 singles and a doubles and all matches will be the best of 5 games
 - 5.4 Play will be on a knockout or group basis at the discretion of the Referee.
 - 5.5 Order of play will be A v X, B v Y, doubles, A v Y, B v X.
 - 5.6 Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England Computer Ranking Scheme.
 - 5.7 The additional computer Scheme Levy of £1.00 is included in the entry fee.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Submit entries to Tournament Referee, **TIM HARRIS, 8 Harford Close, Coombe Dingle, Bristol, BS9 2QD** by no later than **Monday 13th November 2017** together with a stamped, self-addressed envelope unless email address given.
2. A separate entry form must be completed for each player.
3. A limited number of programmes will be available on the day and a downloadable copy will be made available and the address of this will be e-mailed with your entry notification reply, informing you of your starting time.
4. If it is necessary to restrict entries, restriction will be on the basis of last received, first out.
5. Competitors will be informed of the times of their opening matches at least 5 days in advance.
6. Refreshments will be available and Sainsbury's store is within 10 minute walking distance (Fox Den Road, BS34 8SS, Saturday open 7am-10pm and Sunday open 10am-4pm), if the venue does not have food available.
7. Changing rooms will be made available for the day.
8. Car Parking is free and on a first come first served basis and is at the owner's risk.
9. There will be no separate practice area.
10. Competitors, coaches, parents and spectators will be admitted to the tournament venue free of charge
11. Match results will be submitted for the inclusion in the Table Tennis England – Computer Ranking Scheme. The weighting factor will be x1.75 for the singles events and x1.25 for the team events.
12. Play will take place on up to 14 Butterfly tables with Butterfly nets scoring machines.
13. Play will be with Butterfly 3 star white plastic balls.
14. Tables will be courted with minimum court size 10m x 5m.
15. Lighting is general and is high frequency fluorescent.
16. Play will be on wooden sports flooring in the sports hall size 36m x 34m with 22m ceiling height.
17. There will be no admission charge. On site free parking is available.
18. Doping and bat testing may take place.
19. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
20. Trophies will NOT be awarded and the prize fund will be in the form of Tees Sport vouchers.
21. No refunds of entry fees will be made after the draw.
