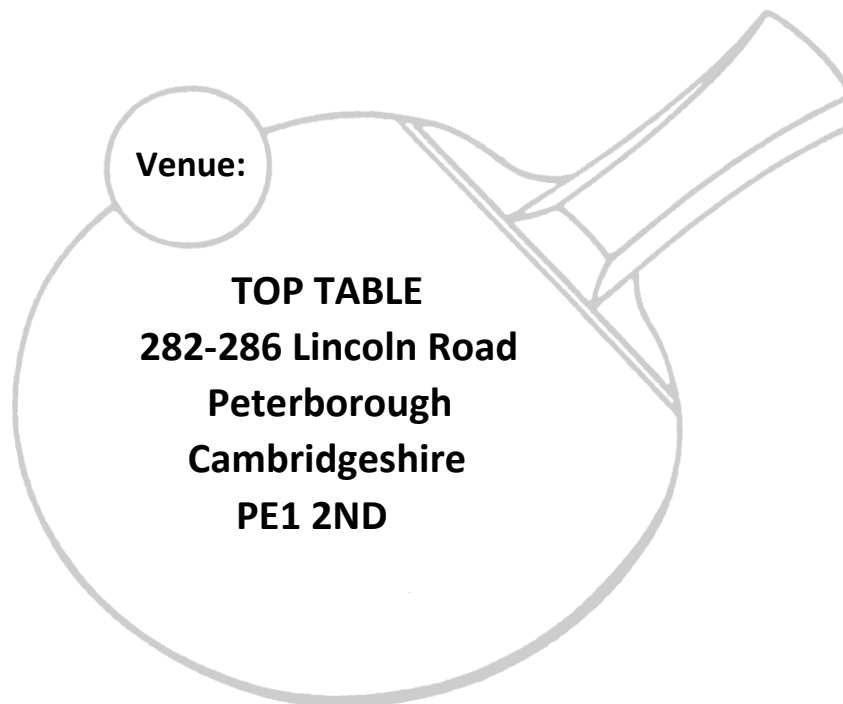

VENUE DIRECTIONS: (postcode PE1 2ND)

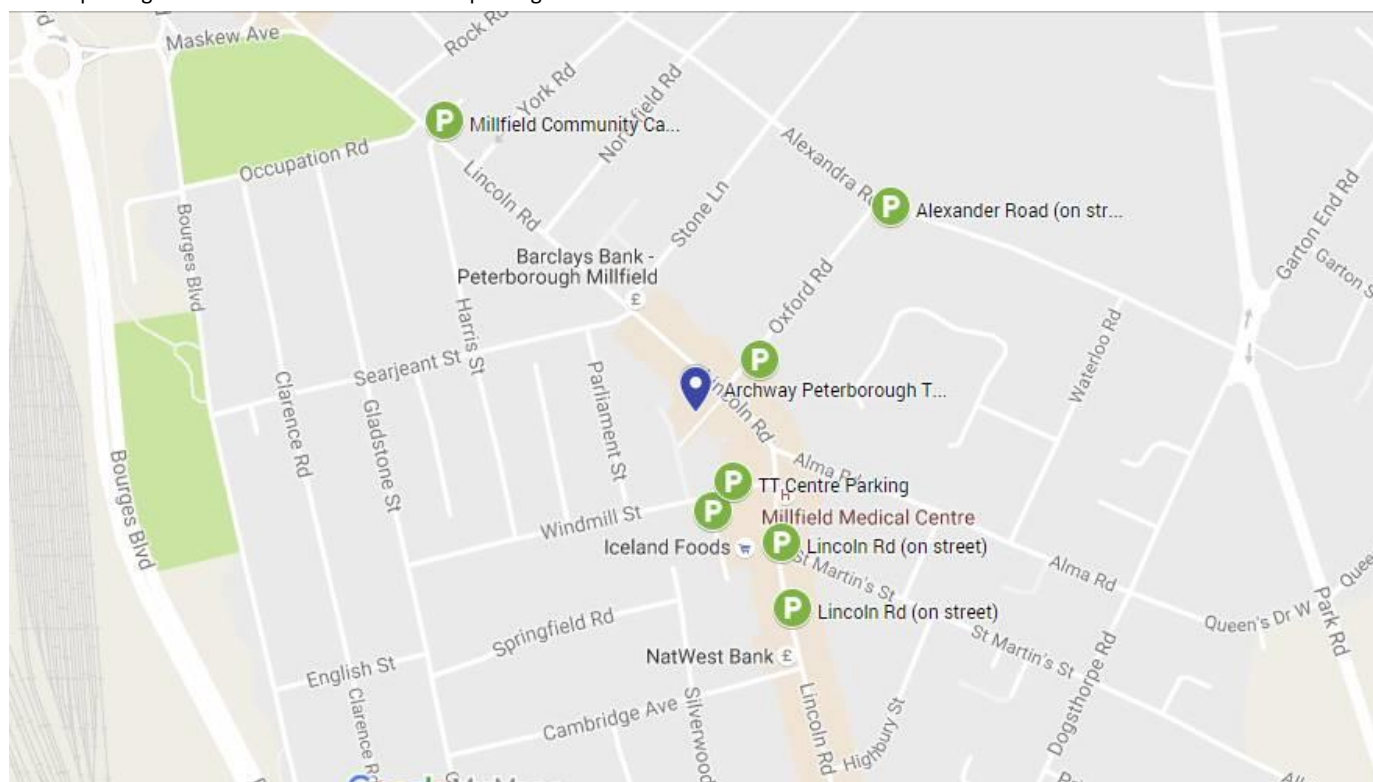
CAR: From the north, exit A1 at junction onto the A47 towards Peterborough (North)/Wisbech. From the south, exit A1 at Peterborough services signposted A1139 Peterborough/Wisbech.

TRAIN: Peterborough railway station is on the London, Kings Cross – Edinburgh line. Venue is 20 minute walk or an 8 minute taxi ride.

BUS: No. 1 from Peterborough bus station (five minute walk from railway station). Ask to get off opposite 'Subway' restaurant on Lincoln Road.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained by entrants)

1. All competitors must be affiliated as a Player Member to Table Tennis England or another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament. ITTF Regulations for International competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
3. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including variations from ITTF requirements.
4. All matches shall be the best of five games.
5. Clothing: Main colour of clothing must be different from ball colour (x). Competitors must wear rubber soled shoes.
6. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
7. All competitors will be required to umpire.
8. Competitors must have been born before 1979
9. No refunds will be made after the date of the setting of the groups except in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Organising committee or where a player provides a doctor's certificate/letter.
10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
11. Competitors must report to the 'booking-in' area on arrival and should not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
12. The Referee's decision shall be final on point of law on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. **Playing format** - competitors will be placed into groups according to the Table Tennis England rating list current in the month the tournament is played. Each group will play a round robin to decide finishing positions. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions. If less than five women enter, then they may be placed in mens groups based on a combination of rating and known ability by the organising committee.
2. **Playing conditions** – play throughout will be on Butterfly ITTF approved tables/nets & posts; and 3* balls (white); Individual courts size 9m x 4.57m enclosed by surrounds; Strip timber semi-sprung floor; Fluorescent (white) lighting at a height of 3m from the floor. Scoring machines may be used.
3. **Entries** – only completed entries with entry fees received by the closing date will be accepted. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, it will be on a last received, first out basis. At the discretion of the referee, entries may be accepted on the day if space permits, however they may be subject to a £5 surcharge.
4. **Refreshments** – light refreshments and drinks will be available for sale. A free snack will be offered to all.
5. **Changing** – the venue offers changing and shower facilities.
6. **Doping** – doping control tests may take place.
7. **Practice** – no separate practice facilities. At the discretion of the Referee, competitors may be permitted to practise on tables not in use.
8. **Notification** – receipt/acceptance of entry will be confirmed by email.
9. **Sudden death KO** – may take place at the beginning of the tournament (£1 entry on the day)
10. **Prizes** – trophies, medals or vouchers may be awarded to group winners and runners up.

The organising committee reserves the right to amend any of the above in the best interests of the competition.
