2. The draw will be held on **Wednesday 24th April 2019** at 36 Crown Way Lillington Leamington Spa CV32 7SE.

3. If it is necessary to restrict entries, restriction will be on the basis of last received, first out. Entries will be limited to 24 entrants in each event. Emailed/late entries will only be accepted if there is still space in the draw after the closing date.

4. Competitors will be informed by email of the times of their opening matches immediately after the draw.

5. There will be refreshments including hot meals and sandwiches available for purchase on the day, together with ample free parking. There are changing room facilities at the school.

6. Play will take place on 6 Sponeta tables with sponeta nets and posts and with scoring machines.

7. Play will be with Nittaku balls (plastic).

8. Tables will be individually courted. Min ceiling height: 5m; Court Size: 10m X 5m.

9. Lighting is with general fluorescent lighting. Light intensity is 500 lux.

10. The venue has a sprung wooden floor.

11. There will be no admission charge.

12. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points

13. Trophies will be awarded in all events for winners & runners-up.

14. Parents & coaches are asked to ensure their children/players do not wander around the building unsupervised.

15. Please note that once an entry is received, no refunds will be offered under any circumstances, other than the case where the player does not get into the event if it is full up.

16. Entrants will need to be flexible with timings, as you will not know which event you are in & therefore what time you are on, until after the closing date.

17. The Entry Form will incorporate a Player's Undertaking as follows:- "I undertake (a) to observe the regulations of the tournament (b) to abide by the decisions of the Referee, and (c) to fulfill the schedule of play arranged for me unless prevented from doing so by circumstances beyond my control and accepted as such by the Referee."

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

1. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) on this entry form.
2. Every entrant must be Affiliated to Table Tennis England as a Player Member or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
3. Every player must hold a valid Table Tennis England Player Licence for season 2018-19 or hold a valid Table Tennis England Player membership and have paid the appropriate Single Competition Licence Fee with their entry form unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to the Table Tennis England.
4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including variations from the ITTF requirements and to the storage of information about the competitor on a computer system.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. All events will be in the same format with up to 40 players in each event. If fully subscribed, there will be groups of 3/4 in each event, with top 2 in each group going through to the knock-out rounds. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Organiser in light of entries received.
6. Competitors may enter all events for which they are eligible.
7. Competitors must report to Control on arrival, and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
8. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel any event if entries are lower than 4.
9. There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of control.
10. Players will be expected to umpire matches during Group play, and may be required to umpire one match in each event entered in any knockout stage. No assistant umpire will be appointed at any stage (x).
11. Players' clothing: Table Tennis England Appendix 'C' to Rules will apply (x)
12. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
13. No gluing up will be allowed in the building.
14. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
15. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
16. All competitors must have been born in 2001 or later for Juniors, in 2004 or later for Cadets, 2006 or later for U13s and 2008 or later for U11s

PRIZES

Medals and vouchers from Jarvis Sports will be awarded to the finalists.

DIRECTIONS & MAP

If approaching from the South: take exit 23 from A14 and take 3rd exit at roundabout onto A141 towards March. At the next roundabout take the first exit towards The Stukeleys and Alconbury. Drive through Great Stukeley and Little Stukeley. After exiting Little Stukeley, take the second turning on the right and the school is straight ahead.

If approaching from the North: from A1 take the A14 exit towards Huntingdon and then take the next slip road towards The Stukeleys and Alconbury. At the roundabout take the second exit towards The Stukeleys and take the next left turn and the school will be straight ahead.

If approaching from the West: on the A14 at junction 23 take the second exit at the roundabout onto A141 towards March. At the next roundabout take the first exit towards The Stukeleys and Alconbury. Drive through Great Stukeley and Little Stukeley. After exiting Little Stukeley, take the second turning on the right and the school is straight ahead.

NB if your SatNav does not recognise the postcode for the school then you will find it on google maps. Alternatively, put in Steve's Car Sales Ermine Street Alconbury PE28 4EW and the entrance to Alconbury Weald development, marked by Hopkins, Redrow and Morris flags, is almost opposite.
