



## 1. Introduction

Table Tennis England respects your privacy. We are committed to ensuring the protection and security of your personal data. We strongly encourage you to take some time to read this Privacy Notice in full.

This Privacy Notice explains the types of personal data that we collect, the purposes for the collection, how the personal data is processed as well as your rights in relation to your personal data.

## 2. The Personal Data That We Collect

When interacting with us, we collect your personal data. The definition of personal data may vary from country to country. To ensure the protection of your personal data, we define it as any information that may directly or indirectly identify you.

The personal data that we collect of each user of our Webinar is the following:

- Yes or No tick box to confirm who attended the Webinar
- Name
- Surname

The collection of the above categories of personal data is done in accordance with the applicable data protection laws.

## 3. Why Do We Collect Your Personal Data?

We collect your personal data in order to provide our Webinar. The objectives of the Webinar are as follows:

- To cultivate awareness and appreciation of the different motives behind match-fixing along with various methods match-fixers use to achieve their goals;
- To demonstrate how the betting industry is used by match-fixers to make a profit, but also to identify and monitor suspicious activity;
- To review applicable integrity rules and the serious consequences if in breach of these rules;
- To let you know how you can get help and report an issue/approach.

## 4. How Do We Process Your Personal Data?

We process your personal data in accordance with the following principles at all times:

- **Lawfulness**

When processing your personal data, we always ensure that the processing is done in accordance with the applicable laws.

- **Transparency**



When collecting your personal data, we strive to provide you with as much information as possible about the processing of your personal data.

- **Purpose Limitation**

Your personal data is collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a manner that is incompatible with the original collection purpose.

- **Data minimization**

We only collect and/or process data which is strictly necessary for our personal data processing activities.

- **Accuracy**

We keep your personal data as accurate as possible and you may rectify your personal data at any time.

- **Storage Limitation**

We do not retain your personal data for longer than it is necessary.

- **Integrity and Confidentiality**

We make use of the appropriate security measures to ensure the protection of your personal data, including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction or damage

## 5. How Long Do We Keep Your Personal Data?

We do not keep your personal data for longer than it is necessary. When keeping your personal data, we take into account legal obligations and the original purpose of collection. The retention period of your personal data is only for the time required for processing its purpose in conjunction with the legislation in force and then proceeding with their anonymisation or destruction.

## 6. On What Legal Basis Do We Process Your Personal Data?

The processing of your personal data is based on your consent. Please note that you may withdraw your consent at any time.
