TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- 1 All entrants must be affiliated as Player Members to Table Tennis England or another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
- 2. Table Tennis England tournament regulations apply to this event.
- 3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
- 4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the Entrant to the Conditions of the Competition including variations from the ITTF requirements.
- 5. All matches shall be the best of five games.
- 6. Preliminary matches will be on a group basis and the final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
- 7. Main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball (x).
- 8. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 9. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
- 10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
- 11. All competitors must report to the referee on arrival and should not leave the premises without first obtaining the referee's permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 12. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the referee reserves the right to cancel that event or merge events or place the entrant in a similar event.
- 13. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations.
- 14. The MIXED INTERMEDIATE SINGLES is open to any male or female who is too old for the juniors or too young for the veterans.
- 15. Players entering the veteran's singles must have been born before 1st January 1980 and juniors must be born on or after 1st January 2002.
- 16. (X) the Prizefighter event is open to all competitors and is played as a group of 3, ALL 3 players will qualify from the group and play in the knock out stages, all group winners will play for 50% of the prize pool, all 2nd placed competitors will play for 30% of the prize pool and all 3rd placed will play for 20% of the prize pool. 100% of the Prizefighter entry fee will go directly into the prize pool. Players will split into three groups depending on their Table Tennis England ranking and the strongest 1/3 will be kept separate in the group stages, as will the second and third tier of players. After the group stages an F A cup style draw will take place with no seedings.
- 17. Player's Undertaking: "I undertake (a) to observe the regulations of the tournament, (b) to abide by the decisions of the Referee, and (c) to fulfill the schedule of play arranged for me unless prevented from doing so by circumstances beyond my control and accepted as such by the Referee.

Tournament Information

- 1. Extra Entry Forms can be obtained via post or E Mail from the organiser.
- 2. The Draw will take place on 9th April 2019 at Scunthorpe Sports Club.
- 3. If an Event is over subscribed entries will be on 'first come first served' basis.
- 4. Notification a list of entries will be put on our website www.scunthorpe-sportsclub.co.uk
- 5. Practice There will be no separate practice facilities but competitors will be allowed to practice on tables not currently in use at the discretion of the referee. .
- 6. Admission There is no entry charge for supporters or spectators.
- 7. Play will take place on Butterfly 22mm tables with Joola net and posts, and White Nittaku premium 3star poly balls. Court sizes will be at least 9m x 4.5m. Ceiling height is 5m and lights which are general fluorescent are 5m above the tables. Playing floor is wood.
- 8. Car parking is available at the venue and light refreshments will be available.
- 9. There are changing facilities.
