### TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

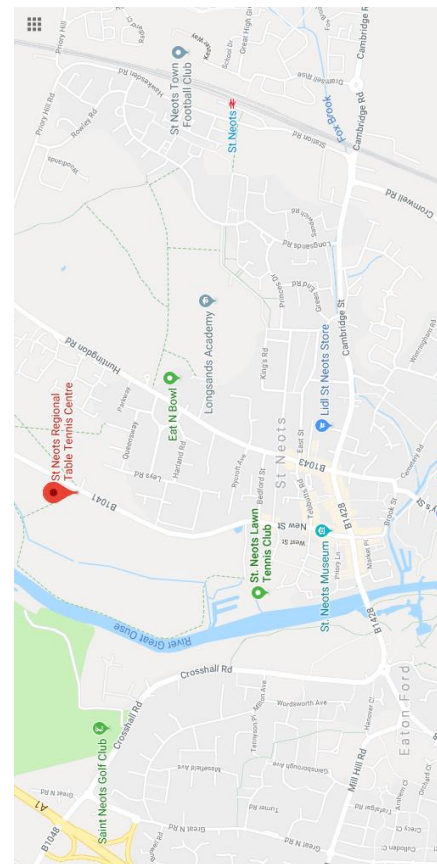
1. ALL entries must be POSTED to: John Mitchell, 13 Greenfields, St Neots, Cambridgeshire, PE19 1SL By no later than Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> Oct 2020, with email address provided, or if not possible, a telephone number.
2. The draw will be held on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> October 2020. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made.
3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt. Entries will be limited to 32 entrants in each event. Emailed/late entries will only be accepted if there is still space in the draw after the closing date.
4. Competitors will be informed by email (if email address provided) or by phone of the times of their opening matches immediately after the draw.
5. There will be refreshments including light snacks (hot and cold) and sandwiches available for purchase on the day, together with ample free parking (at owners risk). There are changing room facilities at the table tennis club.
6. Play throughout will take place on 6 Butterfly Centerfold 25 Tables; Butterfly Nets & Posts and with Butterfly scoring machines.
7. Play will be with Butterfly R40 3 star white 40+mm balls (plastic).
8. Tables will be individually courted. Court Size: 9m X 5m, enclosed by surrounds; Minimum ceiling height: 3.6m.
9. Lighting is with general LED lighting at a minimum height of 3m.
10. The venue has sprung wooden flooring covered by Taraflex flooring.
11. There will be no admission charge.
12. The results from this tournament will qualify for Table Tennis England Computer ranking points.
13. Medals or trophies will be awarded to winners and runners-up for all events.
14. Parents & coaches are asked to ensure their children/players do not wander around the building unsupervised.
15. In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection Policy, persons wishing to take photographs or video images must register with the event organizer, producing their professional identification, TTE authorization or a completed TTE authorization form.
16. Please note that once an entry is received, no refunds will be offered under any circumstances, other than in the case where the player does not get into the event due to it being over-subscribed.
17. Entrants will need to be flexible with timings, as you will not know what time you are on, until after the closing date.
18. Doping control tests may take place.
19. The Entry Form will incorporate a Player's undertaking as follows: - "I undertake (a) to observe the regulations of the tournament (b) to abide by the decisions of the Referee, and (c) to fulfill the schedule of play arranged for me unless prevented from doing so by circumstances beyond my control and accepted as such by the Referee."

## TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

1. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations Part A (Competitive Table Tennis) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to this tournament. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) on this entry form.
2. Every entrant must be Affiliated as a Player Member to Table Tennis England or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
3. Every player must hold a valid Table Tennis England Compete membership (previously known as 'Player Membership') or a TTE Compete Plus membership (previously known as a 'Player Licence') and have paid the appropriate Single Competition Licence Fee with their entry form (if they have a Compete membership) unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to Table Tennis England.
4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including variations from the ITTF requirements and to the storage of information about the competitor on a computer system.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. All events will be in the same format with up to 32 players in each event. If fully subscribed, there will be groups of 3/4 in each event, with top 2 in each group going through to the knock-out rounds. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. The format may be varied at the discretion of the referee in light of entries received.
6. Competitors may enter only two events subject to eligibility (one in the morning and one in the afternoon).
7. Competitors must report to Control on arrival, and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission from the referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
8. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel any event if entries are lower than 4 and may merge with a similar event where possible.
9. There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of the referee.
10. Players will be expected to umpire matches during Group play and knockout stages. No assistant umpire will be appointed at any stage.
11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
12. No gluing up will be allowed in the building.
13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
15. All competitors must have been born in 2003 or later for Junior events or in Cadet events born in 2006 or later.
16. All Competitors must have been born in 2008 or later for Under 13 events and born in or after 2010 for Under 11 events. Players must have been born in 2000 or later for the U21 event.
18. Players clothing: Main colour of clothing must be different from the colour of the ball (white).
19. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law or any questions arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
