**CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021**

This Tournament is NOT a Computer Ranking Scheme Tournament; however, players will be ranked based on latest computer ranking points, no restriction on age/gender (separate gender groups will run if enough entries). Max entries 32 each day.

**Saturday – Juniors** - Under 18s (on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020)

**Sunday - Cadets** - Under 15s (born in or after 2006) & **Juniors** (Under 18s)

Entries will be listed according to current ranking and then split into groups of 8. Each group will then play a Round Robin tournament across 2 tables to decide the winner of each group. If it is necessary to restrict entries, this will be based on last received first out.

**All Group Winners will receive £25 Donic Voucher**  
**All Group Runners up will receive £15 Donic Voucher**

Payment will only be accepted via bank transfer (please see below). Entries will only be accepted with full payment.

Saturday registration and practice will be 12:00, with play to commence at 12:30

Sunday registration and practice will be 09:30, with play to commence at 10:00

## TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

1. Every entrant must be affiliated to Table Tennis England as a Compete Member be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Part A or B, or in this form.
4. All matches will be best of 5 games.
5. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
6. Players' Clothing: Main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball (x).
7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
8. Doping shall not take place either before or during play, and doping control tests may take place.
9. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the Entrant to the conditions of the Competition including variations from ITTF requirements.
10. Court sizes will be 9m x 4.5m, with barriers surrounding each court.
11. Playing conditions – Donic 3\* balls, eight Butterfly centrefold 25mm tables, Butterfly nets and post, LED lighting approx. 4.5m above the table.
12. Flooring in one hall is Gerflor; in the second hall there is a wooden floor.
13. Competition is open on Saturday to any player under the age of 18 (on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020) and on Sunday to any player born in or after 2006 for cadets and as above for Juniors. Groups will be decided using the latest rating list, but the referee will have final decision on groups.
14. There will be no ranking points available for this competition.
15. Closing date for entries is Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
16. Entries received with no payment will not be entered, and if we need to restrict entries, this will be done based on last received first out.
17. The draw will take place on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2021. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made.
18. Notification – players will receive an acknowledgment of entry via email.
19. Competition is open to max 32 players, 4 groups of 8 players, based on last received first out, in the event we reach maximum capacity. In the event total entries received is not divisible by 8, as above, last received first out. Separate boys / girls groups will run dependent upon entries, otherwise groups will be mixed genders.
20. You will play all your matches across 2 tables, which will be assigned upon entry into the centre.
21. Any player who is showing COVID symptoms must not attend.
22. Payment will be made at point of entry to avoid any collecting of cash upon entry to the building.
23. The organiser will be the COVID officer to monitor and ensure guidelines are being adhered to.
24. 2 players and 1 umpire in each court maximum. Umpire will sit at side of table, but with no scoring machine, to call out the score.
25. Scores will be written onto the scoresheet per table.
26. There will be no spectators allowed in the hall during play, all parents/coaches can park in the car park and their child can visit in between games but must be available for their game and umpire when required. There will be sufficient seats for the 2 non-participants in each group, while matches are being played, outside the courts, spaced at 2 metres apart to ensure social distancing.
27. Competitors are not required to pay an admission charge to the venue.
28. Players will be able to swap ends during the matches, tables can be cleaned between matches if required, cleaning solution will be available in each hall, players to clean tables during competition, organiser will ensure all tables cleaned prior to start of play.
29. There will be a one-way system across both the halls, and this will be sent to all players prior to competition, and the organiser will remind all players prior to start of play.
30. Players will be invited into the hall via the entrance area at arrival time and showed to the respective playing area.
31. Doors will be kept open where possible to increase ventilation.
32. Hands need to be sanitised upon entry to the centre, which is provided at the entrance, but players are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitiser.
33. Players are to maintain social distancing when changing between matches.
34. Players should refer to government guidelines with regards to using public transport or car sharing.
35. There will be 2 match balls per table, at the end of each match, the ball will be cleaned by the organiser ready for the next match.
36. The organiser will be the only person to make any adjustments to tables, nets and barriers.
37. There will be no handshaking, slapping hands between players and umpires.
38. Masks should always be worn when not playing. Players can recover from their matches, prior to putting their mask on.
39. Changing rooms, showers and the social area will not be able to be accessed, players will need to take their kit with them to the court.
40. All fees are non-refundable, and full payment will need to be submitted to secure your entry.
41. Car parking at centre (at owner's own risk).
42. Practise - there will be no separate practise facilities, and play will commence Saturday 12:30 and Sunday 10:00
43. There will be none of the following allowed to happen, if it does, penalty points will be awarded (one point awarded to opponent) in brackets, spitting in court (1 penalty point), wiping hands on table (1 penalty point), using saliva to clean bat or ball (2 penalty points), cleaning bat or table with towel (1 penalty point).
