TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)

1. Every entrant must be affiliated to Table Tennis England or of another National Association in membership of the ITTF. **Every player must hold a valid Table Tennis England Compete membership (previously known as 'Player Membership') or a TTE Compete Plus membership (previously known as a 'Player Licence') and have paid the appropriate Single Competition Licence Fee with their entry form (if they have a Compete membership)** unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to Table Tennis England.
2. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
3. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signify agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including the variations from the ITTF requirements.
4. Competitors may be required to umpire group matches at the discretion of the Referee.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis with the exception of preliminary rounds, which may, at the discretion of the Referee, be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions.
6. Competitors in Junior events must be born in 2003 or later. Competitors in Cadet events must be born in 2007 or later. Competitors in Under 13 events must be born in 2009 or later.
7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
8. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
9. All competitors must report to the control on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
10. Competitors in Banded Singles events – this event will be rated using Table Tennis England rating list current at closing date.
 - (a) Junior Boys Band 1 Singles – 551 – 850 rating points
Junior Boys Band 2 Singles – 0 – 550 rating points
 - (b) Junior Girls Band 1 Singles – 351 – 575 rating points
Junior Girls Band 2 Singles – 0 – 350 rating points
 - (c) Cadet Boys Band 1 Singles – 451 – 750 rating points
Cadet Boys Band 2 Singles – 0 – 450 rating points
 - (d) Cadet Girls Band 1 Singles – 151 – 290 rating points
Cadet Girls Band 2 Singles – 0 – 150 rating pointsDummy rankings will be used for foreign entrants.
11. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
12. The referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final
13. Racket testing may take place.

2. Draw - The draw will take place at 7:00pm on Tuesday 17th August 2021 at 5 Alisan Road, Carleton, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire. FY6 7QF.
3. Admission - There will be no charge for admission.
4. Playing Conditions - Play throughout will be on 18 Butterfly tables & nets, Stiga 3* white 40+ balls, Gransprung & pvc floor and 750 lux LED lighting a minimum of 5m above the table. Court size will be 10m x 5m (x) enclosed by surrounds. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
5. Doping - Doping control tests may take place.
6. Practice - There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
7. Car Parking - Car parking (at owner's risk) is available at the venue.
8. Refreshments - Light refreshments will be on sale.
9. Prizes – Trophies will be awarded to all Winners & Runners Up.
10. Notification - Competitors will be notified of the time of their first match.

Junior 4* Tournaments – Entry Qualifications

If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, this will be on the basis of last received first out, with the following exception:

For players affiliated to Table Tennis England, valid entries for Junior Boys rated 1-50 in the rating list current at the closing date, Junior Girls rated 1-32, Cadet Boys rated 1-32 and Cadet Girls rated 1-32 are guaranteed to be accepted. Thereafter, entries will be accepted in order of receipt, with priority given to Junior Boys rated 51-500 and Junior Girls rated 33-250.

No entry will be accepted unless the following undertaking is signed:

1. To observe the regulations of the tournament.
2. To abide by the decisions of the Referee and Organising Committee.
3. To fulfil the schedule of play arranged for me unless prevented by circumstances beyond my control and accepted as such by the Referee.
