**THIS SHEET IS TO BE RETAINED BY THE ENTRANT FOR INFORMATION  
TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS**

1. Every entrant must be affiliated to Table Tennis England as a Compete Plus Member; or affiliated as a TTE Compete Member and have paid the appropriate Single Competition License Fee with their entry form; or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to Table Tennis England.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
3. This Tournament is included in the Computer Ranking Scheme.
4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF requirements.
5. Players may be expected to umpire group matches at the discretion of the Referee.
6. Play throughout for all events will be on a knockout basis except for the first round of each singles event, which will be on a group basis. In a group or "round robin" competition each member of the group shall compete against every other member. Two match points will be awarded for a win, one for a loss in a played match, and zero for an un-played or uncompleted match. The ranking order shall be decided primarily by the number of match points gained. If at the completion of the group two or more members of the group have gained the same number of match points the equality shall be resolved as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
7. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points.
8. Competitors must be born in 2011 or later (Under 11), 2009 or later (Under 13), 2007 or later (under 15 cadet) and 2003 or later (Under 19 junior)
9. Rackets: ITTF Regulations 3.2.1.3, 3.4.2.2 apply: A list of approved racket coverings can be found on [www.ittf.com](http://www.ittf.com)
10. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 *amended*. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 *amended*.
11. At the discretion of the Referee competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables not in use. NO CROSS KNOCKING. Dedicated practice tables will not be available.
12. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
13. The preliminary rounds of all events will be played in groups of 3 or 4 players, following which the players finishing first and second will qualify for the championship events and the players finishing third or fourth will qualify for the consolation events. In the event of several non-arrivals resulting in incomplete groups the Referee reserves the right to disband the highest numbered incomplete group and to redistribute the players present in that group among other incomplete groups to fill any vacancies.
14. Decisions on points of fact by an Umpire or Assistant Umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law, in any dispute as to the interpretation of these Regulations and in any matter not covered by them.
15. Entrants who do not attend the tournament without a reason acceptable to the Referee may be reported to Table Tennis England.
16. Doping tests may take place. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
17. Competitors will not be allowed to glue up within the confines of the Centre under any circumstances.
18. All players will be identified by numbers which must be worn at all times when a competitor is participating in any event.
19. An Assistant Umpire will be appointed for finals only at the Referee's discretion.
20. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
21. Notification will be sent after the draw has been made, notifying competitors of the first match time for each event they have entered, provided they have supplied either an **email address** or a **stamped addressed envelope**.
22. The organising committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Entrants must sign the undertaking to “observe regulations, abide by the decisions of the Referee, and fulfil the schedule of play”. **Unsigned entries will not be accepted.**

The draw will take place on **6<sup>th</sup> February 2022**.

**No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made. No refund of entry fees will be given after the draw has taken place.**

### **Junior 4-star tournaments - Entry Qualifications**

If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt, except that all valid entries for Junior Boys rated 1-50 in the Rating List current at the closing date and for Junior Girls, Cadet Boys and Cadet Girls rated 1-32 will be accepted, with priority thereafter being given to Junior Boys rated 51-500 and Junior Girls rated 33-250.

## **VENUE**

There is no charge for admission to the venue. Free car parking is available at the Centre at owners' risk. The café will be open providing hot and cold meals, drinks and snacks. Changing rooms and hot showers are available at the Venue. Smoking is **NOT** allowed in any area of the venue.

## **PLAYING CONDITIONS**

Play will be on 11 Joola Duomat tables with Joola nets and posts and Xushaofa 3\*star white plastic balls. Court size will be 10m by 5m and will have full Joola surrounds. Minimum height of playing area is 4.0m. Minimum height of the general fluorescent lighting is 4.0m with intensity 500 lux over the playing surface. Flooring: Gerflor blue.

#### Directions to Venue

**From Exeter** – When arriving at Plymouth take the B3413 towards Leigham/Estover.

At the roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto Delamere Road.

At the 3<sup>rd</sup> mini roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit (turn right) onto Eggbuckland Road.

At the first mini roundabout take the first exit and stay on Eggbuckland Road.

Take a left turn onto Frogmore Avenue (this road then becomes Culver Way).

At the roundabout take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto Westcott Close and continue straight ahead onto the school grounds (through double red gates). Head towards the Sports Hall.

**From Cornwall** – When arriving in Plymouth from the Tamar Bridge follow the A38 taking the first exit towards St Budeaux/Ernesettle.

At the roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto Crownhill Road/B3413.

Continue on Crownhill Road for approximately 2.3 miles before turning right onto Widey Lane.

Stay on Widey Lane through 2 mini roundabouts.

At the 3<sup>rd</sup> roundabout take the first exit onto Westcott Close and continue straight ahead onto the school grounds (through double red gates). Head towards the Sports Hall.
